This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.M.Balakumar, Learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner and the Learned Public Prosecutor Thiru.B.Venkatesan, on behalf of the Complainant and this Court passed the following,

**ORDER**

This e-petition is filed by the petitioner to modify the condition imposed on him by this Court as per order passed in Cr.M.P.No.1409/2025, dated 08.06.2026.

Heard both sides. Perused the records.

Notice was issued. Reply was filed by the prosecution.

The Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that he was ordered to be released on anticipatory bail by this court in CrI.M.P.No.1409/2026 on 08.06.2026 that the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail with condition that the petitioner shall stay at Nagappattinam District and shall report and sign before the Station House Officer of Nagappattinam Town Police Station daily at 10.30 a.m. for 30 days. He further submits that the petitioner undergone a head surgery and taking medicines. Hence he wants to modify the condition.

The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the accused was ordered to be released on anticipatory bail by this court in CrI.M.P.No.1409 /2025 on 08.06.2026 that the petitioner shall stay at Nagappattinam District and shall report and sign before the Station House Officer of Nagappattinam Town Police Station daily at 10.30 a.m. for 30 days and if the condition is modified, again he may do the same kind of offence and raised objection to allow this petition.

In view of submissions put forth on both and considering the facts and to meet the ends of justice, this petition is allowed and one of the condition imposed in the order passed in Cr.M.P.No.1409/2025 on 08.06.2026 is modified to the effect that **the petitioner shall stay at Rameshwaram and shall report and sign before the Rameshwaram Temple Police Station daily twice at 10.30 a.m. and 05.00 p.m. for 15 days instead of shall report and sign before the Station House Officer of Nagappattinam Town Police Station daily at 10.30 a.m. for 30 days** and rest of the conditions are unaltered.
