This petition was filed through CIS and came before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.S. Ramesh Babu, B.A.,B.L., Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused and of Thiru. M.Senthilkumar,B.A.,LL.B.,(Hons.) Learned Special Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, this court after perusing the records passed the following:

ORDER

This petition has been filed u/s 483 of BNSS Act /439 of Cr.P.C. to release the petitioner/accused on bail.

2. The Petitioner/Accused was alleged to have committed the offence u/s 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(B)of NDPS Act 1985 and he was remanded to Judicial Custody on 11.06.2026 .

3. The Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner/accused is innocent and he has not committed any offences as alleged and that he is alleged to have found in possession of 2.000 Kg of Ganja and he has been in Judicial Custody from 11.06.2026 and that he is ready to obey any condition imposed by this court and that for his released on bail and hence it is prayed that he may be released on bail on any condition.

4. The Respondent has strongly objected to grant bail by filing written objection of the respondent stating that if he is released on bail he will abscond and commit similar kind of offences.

5. Heard both sides.

6. Considering the above facts and circumstances of this case and that the petitioner/ accused was allegedly found to be in possession of 2.000 Kg of Ganja and that he has been in custody for the past 26 *d*ays and this court is inclined to release the accused on bail with condition.

7. In the result, the petitioner/accused is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for like sum to the satisfaction of this court on condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., for the period of Fifteen days.
