This petition was filed through CIS and came before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.G. Jayaprakash, B.A.,B.L., Counsel for the Petitioners/Accused and of Thiru. M. Sethilkumar,B.A.,LL.B(Hons.) Learned Special Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, this court after perusing the records passed the following:

ORDER

This petition has been filed u/s 483 of BNSS Act /439 of Cr.P.C. to release the petitioners/accused on bail.

2. The Petitioners/Accused are alleged to have committed the offence u/s 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(B) of NDPS Act 1985 and they were remanded to Judicial Custody on 22.06.2026.

3. The Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioners/accused are an innocent and they have not committed any offences as alleged and that they were alleged to have found in possession of 1.200 Kg of Ganja and they have been in Judicial Custody from 22.06.2026 and that they are ready to obey any condition imposed by this court for their release on bail and hence it is

prayed that they may be released on bail on any condition.

4. The Respondent has strongly objected to grant bail by filing written objection of the respondent stating that previous cases were pending against the petitioners/accused and that if they were released on bail and they will abscond and commit similar kind of offences.

5. Heard both sides.

6. Considering the above facts and circumstances of this case very serious in nature and the offence alleged is against the petitioners/accused and previous offence against society strong objection by the prosecution and investigation is not yet completed and hence this court is not inclined to release the petitioner/accused on bail .

7. In the result, this bail petition is dismissed.
