(Application for release of Vehicle (Canter/Truck) Bearing Registration No. PB06L9631 on Superdari)

ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application for releasing the Vehicle i.e. Canter/Truck bearing Registration No. PB06L9631 on sapurdari.
2. In the present application, it is submitted that the vehicle Canter/Truck bearing Registration No. PB06L9631 is lying with the Police Post Focal Point, PS. Transport Nagar, Division No.8, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar and the said vehicle is no more required by

the police for any investigation as the investigation has been completed and its value will be decreased if it remains in police station because of want of maintenance. The applicant is in need of the above said vehicle for plying the same because it is public carrier and the applicant is use to ply the above said vehicle for the transportation of goods almost daily and the applicant wants to get it release on Supardari and if the present application is not allowed then the applicant shall suffer with heavy financial loss. Lastly, it is prayed for allowing the application.

3. **Alongwith the application,** the applicant has placed on record copy of FIR, copy of Adhar card, copy of insurance, copy of permit, copy of RC showing the applicant as owner of the vehicle in question.

4. **Upon filing of the application,** report from concerned police station was called and same has been received, wherein, In-charge, Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar has reported that as per the record verification of RTA office, the actual owner of Canter/Truck brand EICHER No. PB06-L-9631 is petitioner Paramjit Singh. The said vehicle is not required for further investigation. The local police has no objection in handing over the said vehicle to its original owner, petitioner Paramjit Singh.

5. **I have heard ld. Counsel for the applicant** and Ld. APP for the State and have also gone through the record carefully. The concerned police has reported that vehicle in question was taken into their possession and they have no objection if the same be released in favour of original owner. The RC attached with the application shows that applicant is the

registered owner of the vehicle in question. Thus, in view of the present circumstances and after careful perusal of the documents placed on record, the present application is hereby **allowed** and the said vehicle i.e. Canter/Truck bearing Registration No.PB06L9631 is ordered to be released to the applicant on sapurdari, subject to furnishing sapurdari bonds in the sum of Rs.5 Lakhs with one surety in the like amount and subject to the following conditions:-

- a. That the applicant shall undertake to produce the said vehicle in the court on each and every date of hearing or as and when so directed by the court;
- b. That he will not change the colour and condition of the said vehicle;
- c. That he will not sell, alienate, mutilate and dispose of the said vehicle in any manner to anybody during the pendency of the case and without the prior permission of the court and subject to the claim of rightful owner till end of trial.

6. **Accordingly**, the present application stands disposed off. Sapurdari bonds not furnished. The file be attached with the FIR/remand papers/challan, if any.
