Petition dated: 27.02.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.S.Mohammed Natheem., B.Sc., B.L., the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.KR.M.Karunaivel Pandiyan, B.Com., B.L., representing on behalf of the learned Public Prosecutor Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court passes the following:

**ORDER**

The petitioner/A2 who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 26.02.2026 in Cr.No.32/2026 on the file of the respondent police for the offence punishable U/s.296(b) BNS and section 25(1-A) Arms Act r/w section 4(1)(i), 4(1)(A) of TNP (Amendment) Act, 2024, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that, while the respondent police were on patrolling duty on 13.02.2026 at about 8.30 a.m, they found that the petitioner and



another have illegally in possession of swords and were threatening the public in filthy language and on seeing the police one of the accused fled away from the place of occurrence and also he has in possession of 50 grams of Ganja (10 grms x 5 pockets) kept in sip-log covers without any valid permit or licence for the purpose of selling at high prices in public. Further, the petitioner was apprehended by the police along with the said properties and in consequence thereof, the present case was registered.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and that he was arrested on 26.02.2026 and he is in judicial custody for the past 15 days and that the properties involved in this case have been recovered by the police and that most of the investigation has been completed. He further submitted that A1 was released on bail by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.346/2026 on 27.02.2026 and that if the petitioner is released on bail, he is ready to obey the conditions imposed if any by this court and he would not abscond and also not tamper or threaten the witnesses and he prays to release the petitioner on bail.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor contended that totally 2 accused are involved in this case and that the petitioner is arrayed as A2 and A1 was released on bail by this Court CrI.M.P.No.346/2026 on 27.02.2026. He further submitted that the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 26.02.2026 and that the



property (one sword and 50 grms of Ganja) involved in this case have been recovered. He further submitted that 5 witnesses have been examined and that one previous case is pending against the petitioner for the offences u/s.160 IPC and that if the petitioner is released on bail, he would indulge in similar offence again.

5. There is no similar nature of previous case pending against the petitioner and he is in judicial custody for more than 14 days. However, considering the nature of the offence, the period of incarceration, the fact that the property has already been secured, that the substantial part of the investigation is over and also that the release of co-accused, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following stringent conditions:

i) that the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on execution of a bond for a sum Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only) **with two sureties** for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram;**

ii) Before execution of bond, **the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) as non-refundable to the Credit of District Mediation Centre, Ramanathapuram;**

iii) **that the petitioner shall produce undertaking affidavit that he shall not involve in similar type of offence in future at the time of furnishing sureties;**

iv) that the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card



or Bank pass book to ensure their identity;

v) that the **petitioner shall report before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram daily once at 10.30 a.m for a period of one month** and on further condition that he shall make available himself for interrogation as and when required by the investigation Officer;

vi) that the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witnesses either during investigation or trial;

vii) that the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

viii) that on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the **Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji-vs- State of Kerala(2005) AIR- SCW- 5560;**

ix) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/s.269 BNS, 2023.
