Petition dated: 03.03.2026 U/s.483(1)(b) BNSS to relax the bail condition imposed on the petitioner.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.S.Chellamani, B.A., B.L., the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.B.Karthikeyan, B.A., B.L., the learned Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides arguments, this Court passes the following...

**ORDER**

The petitioner/sole accused was granted bail vide order of this court in CrI.M.P.No.2406/2025 dated 24.10.2025 with a condition to report before the Inspector of Police, Thallakulam P.S., Madurai District daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m for a period of one month. Further, the above said condition was modified as the petitioner shall report before the Inspector of Police, CBCID P.S.,



Virudhunagar daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m for a period of one month in CrI.M.P.No.298/2026 dated 13.02.2026. Now the petitioner has filed this petition seeking to relax the bail condition imposed on him.

2. The Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been complying the condition the Inspector of Police, CBCID P.S., Virudhunagar daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m from 15.02.2026 to till date. Since, the petitioner is the only bread winner of his family, it is very difficult to comply the condition and prays to relax the bail condition imposed on him.

3. The Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner has been complying the condition the Inspector of Police, CBCID P.S., Virudhunagar daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m from 15.02.2026 to 05.03.2026 for the past 19 days only.

4. Considering the nature of offence and the complying period of the condition, this court is inclined to modify the condition that the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before **“the Inspector of Police, CBCID P.S., Virudhunagar weekly once i.e., every Monday at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m for further remaining period”** in CrI.M.P.No.2406/2025 dated 24.10.2025.

In the result, the condition is modified that **the petitioner/accused shall report**
