Petition dated: 03.03.2026 U/s.483(1)(b) BNSS to relax the bail condition imposed on the petitioners.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.Jothimurugan, M.A., B.L., the learned Counsel for the petitioners and of Thiru.B.Karthikeyan, B.A., B.L., the learned Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides submissions, this Court passes the following:

ORDER

The petitioners/A1, A2 were granted bail vide order of this court in



CrI.M.P.No.226/2026 dated 16.02.2026 with a condition to report before the Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m for a period of one month. Now the petitioners have filed this petition seeking to relax the bail condition imposed on them.

2. The Learned Counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioners have been complying the condition before Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m from 19.02.2026 to till date. Since, the petitioners are only bread winner of their family, it is very difficult to comply the condition and prays relax the bail condition imposed on them.

3. The Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioners have been complying the condition before Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m from 19.02.2026 to 05.03.2026 for the past 15 days only.

4. Considering the nature of offence and that the period of complying the condition, this court is inclined to modify the condition that the petitioners are directed to appear and sign before **“ The Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., daily once at 10.30 a.m for further remaining period”** in CrI.M.P.No.226/2026 dated 16.02.2026.

In the result, the condition is modified that **the petitioners/accused shall report before “ The Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., daily once at 10.30 a.m for**
