Further, the above said condition was modified as the petitioner shall report before this Court weekly once i.e., on every Monday at 10.30 a.m or until further orders in CrI.M.P.No.230/2026 dated 04.02.2026. Now the petitioner has filed this petition seeking to relax the bail condition imposed on him.

2. The Learned Counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been complying the condition before this Court weekly once i.e., on every Monday at 10.30 a.m from 09.02.2026 to till date. Since, the petitioner is the only bread winner of his family, it is very difficult to comply the condition and prays to relax the bail condition imposed on him.

3. The Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner has been complying the condition before this Court weekly once i.e., on every Monday at 10.30 from 09.02.2026 to 02.03.2026 for the past 4 days.

4. Considering the submissions made on both sides the petitioner has been complied the condition weekly once for 4 days. Hence, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.111/2026 dated 21.01.2026 and he shall appear before this Court on each and every hearing without fail.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the
