Petition dated : 04.03.2026 prays to extension of time to produce the sureties in CrI.M.P.No.170/2026 dated 05.02.2026.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.T.Muneeswaran, B.A., B.L., the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.B.Karthikeyan, B.A., B.L., the learned Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides arguments, this Court passes the following:

ORDER

The petition has been filed by the petitioner for extension of time to produce the sureties as per the order passed in CrI.M.P.No.170/2026 dated 05.02.2026.

2. Heard, the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the learned Public Prosecutor.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner was



granted anticipatory bail by this Court, in CrI.M.P.No.170/2026 dated 05.02.2026 with a condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Rameswaram** within a period of 15 days from the date of above said order. Due to ill health of the petitioner, he could not produce the sureties in time before the concerned Court and seeks to extend the time to comply the conditional order imposed in CrI.M.P.No.170/2026 dated 05.02.2026.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor would submit that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court, in CrI.M.P.No.170/2026 dated 05.02.2026 and hence he has no serious objection for extension of time to produce the sureties.

5. Having considered the facts and reasons stated in this petition and prayer of the petitioner seeking extension of time can be accepted in the interest of justice on condition that the petitioner pays **Rs.1000/- (Rupees Thousand only)** to the **District Mediation Centre, Ramanathapuram** and to produce the sureties as ordered in CrI.M.P.No.170/2026 dated 05.02.2026 is hereby extended for 13 days from today is granted.

In the result, the petition is allowed on condition that the petitioner pays **Rs.1000/- (Rupees Thousand only)** on or before 10.03.2026 to the District Mediation Centre, Ramanathapuram on such payment of time is extended till
