Petition dated 04.03.2026 prays to relax the anticipatory bail condition imposed on the petitioners.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.M.Raja Sahul Hameed, B.Sc., B.L., the learned Counsel for the petitioners and of Thiru.B.Karthikeyan, B.A., B.L., the learned Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides arguments, this Court passes the following...

ORDER

The petitioners/A1, A2 who was granted anticipatory bail vide order of this Court, in CrI.M.P.No.2111/2025 dated 09.09.2025 with a condition to attend one



week awareness programme regarding importance of the Environment and Ecology at the Interpretation Centre, Kundhukal, Pamban, after that to report and sign before the respondent range daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m until further orders. Further, the above said condition was modified as the petitioners/accused shall report before the Inspector of Police, Respondent Range, monthly once i.e., 1st working day of every English Calender at 10.30 a.m. for until further orders in CrI.M.P.No.2762/2025 dated 16.12.2025. Now the petitioners have filed this petition seeking to relax the anticipatory bail condition imposed on them.

2. The Learned Counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioners have been complying the condition before the Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., monthly once i.e., 1st working day of every English Calender at 10.30 a.m from 05.01.2026 to till date. Since, the petitioners are the only bread winners of their family, it is very difficult to comply the condition and prays to relax the bail condition imposed on them.

3. The Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioners have been complying the condition before the Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., monthly once i.e., 1st working day of every English Calender at 10.30 a.m from 05.01.2026 to 02.03.2026 for 3 days.

4. Considering the submissions made on both sides that the petitioners have

complied the condition monthly once for 3 months and that the investigation is over, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed on the petitioners in CrI.M.P.No.2111/2025 dated 09.09.2025.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioners is totally relaxed.
