Petition dated: 06.03..2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.M.Kesavan, B.A., L.L.B., PGD., the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.KR.M.Karunaivel Pandiyan, B.Com., B.L., representing on behalf of the learned Public Prosecutor Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both side submissions, this Court passes the following:

ORDER

The petitioner/A3 who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 24.02.2026 in Cr.No.31/2026 on the file of the respondent police for the offences punishable U/s.126(2), 296(b), 115(2), 109(1) of BNS, seeks bail.



2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant and all the accused are friends and there is some misunderstanding between them. Subsequently, on 23.02.2026 at about 9.30 p.m while the defacto complainant was going to his house at that time the petitioners and others way laid him and abused him in filthy language and attacked with hand ring, sickle, stone and hands and caused injuries on his face, right eye, stomach and head and also threatened with dire consequence and on complaint, the case was registered.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in no way connected with the offence. He further submitted that the petitioner was arrested on 24.02.2026 and he is in judicial custody for the past 18 days and that most of the investigation is over . He further submitted that the injured was discharged from hospital and that there is specific overt-act against this petitioner is that he pushed the injured with hands and no weapon is attributed to this petitioner and that the earlier application was dismissed by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.402/2026 dated 04.03.2026 and that if the petitioner is released on bail, he is ready to obey the conditions imposed if any and he would not abscond and also not tamper or threaten the witnesses. Hence he prays to release the petitioner on bail.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor contended that totally 3 accused are involved in this case and the petitioner is arrayed as A3 and others are in judicial custody. He



further submitted that the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 24.02.2026 and that the injured was discharged from hospital on 01.03.2026 and that the victim had sustained injuries on his head and that five witnesses have been examined . He further submitted that some application to cancel the bail in another case and also been filed for not obeying the condition and that the victim is discharged, but bail petition for co-accused was dismissed on 12.03.2026 and objected to release the petitioner on bail.

5. There is a specific overt act against the petitioner is that he pushed the victim with his hands. However, the case has been registered under Section 109(1) of the BNS. It is to earlier dispute, specific overt-act of the accused. Only five witnesses have been examined so far. The petitioner has a history of not obeying the conditions imposed while granting bail. Hence, considering the nature of the offence, the period of incarceration, the fact that the investigation is in initial stage, and also that he has not obeyed the bail conditions earlier, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.

In the result, the bail petition is dismissed.
