This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.K.Muthuduraisamy, B.A., B.L., the learned Counsel for the petitioners and of Thiru.B.Karthikeyan, B.A., B.L., the learned Public Prosecutor Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both side submissions, this Court passes the following:



ORDER

The petitioners/1,6 who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.02.2026 in Cr.No.50/2026 on the file of the respondent police for the offences punishable U/s.189(2), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1) BNS, seek bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is the father of the victim. On 21.02.2026 at about 12:00 p.m., the defacto complainant's son was standing at Kandhasampuram Colony. At that time, the petitioners and others came there, abused him in filthy language, and A1 assaulted him with a scissor on the left side of his head, near the ear, and on the backside. The other accused attacked him with their hands and caused injuries. Based on the complaint, a case was registered.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and they are in no way connected with the offence. He further submitted that the petitioners were arrested on 22.02.2026 and they are in judicial custody for the past 17 days and that the injured was discharged from hospital and that most of the investigation is over. He further submitted that A4, A5, A7 were released on bail by this Court in CrI.M.P.Nos.385/2026, 376/2026



on 02.03.2026 and that if the petitioners are released on bail, they are ready to obey the conditions imposed if any and they would not abscond and also not tamper or threaten the witnesses. Hence he prays to release the petitioners on bail.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor contended that totally 7 accused are involved in this case and the petitioners are arrayed as A1, A6 and that A4, A5, A7 were released on bail by this Court in CrI.M.P.Nos.385/2026, 376/2026 on 02.03.2026 and that A3 is a juvenile in conflicted with law and A2 was deleted from this case. He further submitted that the petitioners were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.02.2026 and that the injured was discharged from hospital on 25.02.2026 and that A1 assaulted the victim with a scissor on the left side of his head, near the ear, and on the backside and he had sustained injuries. He further submitted that eight witnesses have been examined and that 2 previous cases are pending against the 1st petitioner/A1 for the offences 506(ii) IPC including NDPS Act and Arms Act and that 4 previous cases are pending against the 2nd petitioner/A6 for the offences u/s.457, 380 IPC and 3 cases are 379 IPC. He further submitted that earlier bail application was dismissed by this court in CrI.M.P.No.385/2026 on 02.03.2026.



5. Earlier bail application was dismissed on 02.03.2026. There are previous cases pending against the petitioners. However, considering the nature of the offence, the period of incarceration, the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital, and that a major part of the investigation has been completed and release of co-accused, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, subject to the following conditions:

i) that the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on bail on execution of a bond **for a sum Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties** for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate, Mudukulathur;**

ii) that the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or Bank pass book to ensure their identity;

iii) Considering the facts of the previous cases, the **petitioners shall report before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Sivagangai, Sivagangai District daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m for a period of one month. The petitioners shall not file any relaxation petition before this court for a period of one month** and on further condition that they shall make available themselves for interrogation as and when required by the investigation Officer;



iv) that the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witnesses either during investigation or trial;

v) that the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

vi) that on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the **Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji-vs- State of Kerala(2005) AIR SCW 5560;**

vii) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/s.269 BNS, 2023.
