Petition dated: 10.03.2026 U/s.483(1)(b) BNSS to relax the bail condition imposed on the petitioner.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.M.Sethupathi, B.E., L.L.B., the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.KR.M.Karunaivel Pandiyan, B.Com., B.L., representing on behalf of the learned Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides submissions, this Court passes the following:

ORDER

The petitioner/A8 was granted bail vide order of this court in CrI.M.P.No.132/2026 dated 22.01.2026 with a condition to report before the learned



District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.00 p.m until committal proceedings of the case. Further, the above said condition was modified as the petitioner/accused shall report before the learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi daily once at 10.30 a.m for until committal proceedings of the case CrI.M.P.No.348/2026 dated 24.02.2026. Now the petitioner has filed this petition seeking to relax the bail condition imposed on him.

2. The Learned Counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been complying the condition before the learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi daily once at 10.30 a.m from 28.02.2026 to till date. Since, the petitioner is the only bread winner of his family, it is very difficult to comply the condition and prays to relax the bail condition imposed on him.

3. The Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner has been complying the condition before the learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi daily once at 10.30 a.m from 28.02.2026 to 12.03.2026 for the past 13 days only.

4. Considering the nature of offence and that the complying period of the condition, this court is inclined to modify the condition that the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before **“the learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi monthly once i.e., on 1st working day of every English Calender Month**

at 10.30 a.m for until committal proceedings of the case” in CrI.M.P.No.132/2026 dated 22.01.2026.

In the result, the condition is modified that **the petitioner/accused shall report before the learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi monthly once i.e., on 1st working day of every English Calender Month at 10.30 a.m for until committal proceedings of the case”** in CrI.M.P.No.132/2026 dated 22.01.2026.
