Petition dated: 10.03.2026 U/s.483 BNSS to grant bail.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.M.Shanmuganathan, M.A., B.L., the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.KR.M.Karunaivel Pandiyan, B.Com., B.L., representing on behalf of the learned Public Prosecutor Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both side submissions, this Court passes the following:

ORDER

The petitioner/A2 who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 24.02.2026 in Cr.No.31/2026 on the file of the respondent police for the offences punishable U/s.126(2), 296(b), 115(2), 109(1) BNS, seeks bail.



2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant and all the accused are friends and there is some misunderstanding between them in respect of the accused are involved in criminal cases, hence the defacto complainant distanced him from them. Subsequently, on 23.02.2026 at about 9.30 p.m while the defacto complainant was going to his house at that time the petitioners and others way-laid him and abused him in filthy language and attacked with hand ring, sickle, stone and hands and caused injuries on his face, right eye, stomach and head and also threatened with dire consequence and on complaint, the case was registered.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in no way connected with the offence. He further submitted that the petitioner was arrested on 24.02.2026 and he is in judicial custody for the past 17 days and that there is no specific over-tact against the petitioner. He further submitted that the injured has been discharged from hospital and that most of the investigation is over and that if the petitioners is released on bail, he is ready to obey the conditions imposed if any and they would not abscond and also not tamper or threaten the witnesses. Hence he prays to release the petitioners on bail.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor contended that there are totally 3 accused involved in this case and that the petitioner is arrayed as A2 and that A1 and A3 are in judicial custody. He further submitted that the petitioner was arrested and



remanded to judicial custody on 24.02.2026 and that that five witnesses have been examined and that the victim was discharged from Govt. hospital on 01.03.2026 and he is taking treatment in the private hospital and that the investigation is in beginning stage. He further submitted that 6 previous cases are pending against the petitioner for the offences u/s.308, 392, 147, 148, 427, 109, 302, 364, 387 IPC including CLA Act and NDPS Act and that there is specific over-tact against the petitioner that he 1st attacked the injured with the steal bracelet and if the petitioner is released on bail, he would threaten the witnesses and tamper the evidence.

5. There are previous cases pending against the petitioner. Even though the injured has been discharged from the Govt. hospital, he is taking treatment in the private hospital. Considering the grave nature of offence and facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the investigation is in beginning stage, and that there is specific over-tact against this petitioner and also considering the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.

In the result, the bail petition is dismissed.
