Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., daily once at 10.30 a.m for a period of one month. Now the petitioners have filed this petition seeking to relax the bail condition imposed on them.

2. The Learned Counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have been complying the condition before the Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., daily once at 10.30 a.m from 21.02.2026 to till date. Since the petitioners are unable to engage in any work, it is very difficult to comply the condition and prays to relax the bail condition imposed on them.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioners have been complied the condition before the Inspector of Police, Respondent P.S., daily once at 10.30 a.m from 21.02.2026 to 12.03.2026 for the past 20 days only.

4. Considering the nature of offence and that the period of complying the condition, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed on the petitioners in CrI.M.P.No.331/2026 dated 19.02.2026.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioner is totally relaxed.
