This petition coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.S.Sasiprem Ananth, M.Com., B.L., the Learned Counsel for the Petitioners and of Thiru.KR.M.Karunaivel Pandiyan, B.Com., B.L., representing on behalf of the Learned Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides arguments, this Court passes the following...

**ORDER**

This petition filed by the petitioners u/s.430(1) of BNSS, seeking to suspend the sentence passed in C.C.No.531/2022 dated 11.03.2026 by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi till the disposal of the criminal appeal.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the learned



Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi has found guilty of the petitioners and sentenced undergo Simple Imprisonment for six months and fine of Rs.1,000/- each I/d Simple Imprisonment for one month for punishable offence U/s.323 IPC (fine already paid) and there is a fair chance to succeeding the case and also argued that the petitioners are the law abiding citizens. Hence, he prays to suspend the execution of sentence passed in C.C.No.531/2022 dated 11.03.2026. Further, the said sentence has been suspended by the trial court in CrI.M.P.No.168/2026, he prays for suspension of sentence till the disposal of the Criminal Appeal.

3. The Learned Public Prosecutor does not raise any serious objection to suspend the sentence against the petitioners/accused.

Accordingly, the substantial sentence alone is suspended till the disposal of the Criminal Appeal and the petitioners/accused is hereby granted bail on execution of bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi. Further, the petitioners are directed to report before the appellate Court as and when directed and also directed to co-operate with appeal proceedings.
