This petition coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of
Thiru.M.Kesavan, B.A., L.L.B., PG.D. the learned Counsel for the petitioner and
Thiru.B.Karthikeyan, B.A., B.L., the learned Public Prosecutor for the State and
upon hearing both sides submissions, this Court passes the following:

ORDER

The petitioner/A3 who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on
14.05.2026 by the respondent police in Cr.No.03/2026 for the offence punishable
U/s. 336(2), 336(3), 340(2), 318(4), 319(2), 61(2) BNS, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners and others created forged
documents relating to the property belonging to the defacto complainant's father and
executed sale deeds among themselves by impersonation. In the year 2012, while the



defacto complainant's father was alive, all the accused allegedly obtained a forged death certificate of the defacto complainant's father and also procured forged legal heir certificates in the names of the accused. Thereafter, they executed sale deeds on various dates among themselves before the document writer and the Sub-Registrar, Velipattinam. On the basis of the complaint, the case was registered.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has not committed any such offence and she has been falsely implicated in this case and that the petitioner was arrested on 14.05.2026 and she is in judicial custody for the past 25 days and that she is the seller of the properties and that the earlier application was dismissed by the learned Judicial Magistrate No. II, Ramanathapuram in CrI.M.P.No.531/2026. He further submitted that most of the investigation is completed and that if the petitioner is released on bail, she is ready to obey the conditions imposed if any by this court and she would not abscond and tamper the witnesses and he prays to release the petitioner on bail.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor contended that totally 20 accused are involved in this case and the petitioner is arrayed as A3 and that A1 was died and that A2, A4, A7, A19 are in judicial custody and that A10, A18, A20 were moved anticipatory bail and that A5 and A6 were released on anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court in CrI.OP(MD).No.9703/2026 dated 21.05.2026 and that A8 was released on anticipatory bail by the Vacation Sessions Court,



Ramanthapuram in CrI.M.P.No.144/2026 dated 27.05.2026 and that others are still absconding. He further submitted that the the petitioner's /A3 overt-act is that she had involved forgery of documents and creation of sale deed and she is the main accused and that the investigation is not yet complete and he objected to release the petitioner on bail.

5. The petitioner/A3 involved forgery of documents and creation of sale deeds based on false document. The investigation is not yet complete as per prosecution. A3/this petitioner is the main accused who had misrepresenting as the legal heir and subsequently sold the properties .

6. Considering the serious nature of offence and the period of incarceration and the fact that the investigation is not yet complete, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.

In the result, this bail petition is dismissed.
