This petition coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.S.Pranavanathan, B.Com., B.L., Learned Counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.KR.M.Karunaivel Pandiya, B.Com., B.L., represented on behalf of the Learned Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides arguments, this Court passes the following...

ORDER

This petition filed by the petitioner u/s.430 of BNSS., seeking to suspend the sentence passed in C.C.No.323/2022 dated 21.03..2025 by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Ramanathapuram till the disposal of the



Criminal Appeal.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Ramanathapuram has found guilty of the petitioner under section 324 IPC and sentenced undergo simple imprisonment for 6 months and fine of Rs.3,000/- in default simple imprisonment for one month and there is a fair chance to succeeding the case and also argued that the petitioner is the law abiding citizen. Hence, he prays to suspend the execution of sentence passed in C.C.No.323/2022 dated 21.03.2025.

4. The Learned Public Prosecutor does not raise any serious objection to suspend the sentence against the petitioner/accused.

5. Accordingly, the substantial sentence alone is suspended till the disposal of the Criminal Appeal and the petitioner/accused is hereby granted bail on execution of bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Ramanathapuram. Further, the petitioner is directed to report before the appellate Court as and when directed and also directed to co-operate with appeal proceedings.
