This petition coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.P.V.Mahendran, B.A., B.L., Learned Counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.B. Karthikeyan, B.A., B.L., the Learned Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides arguments, this Court passes the following...

ORDER

This petition filed by the petitioners u/s.430(1) of BNSS., seeking to suspend the sentence passed in C.C.No.152/2023 dated 09.05.2025 by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ramanathapuram till the disposal of the criminal appeal.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ramanathapuram has found guilty of the petitioners under



section 5(a) and sentenced undergo Rigiours Imprisonment for each 3 years and fine of Rs.1000/-each I/d simple imprisonment for each 3 months for punishable offence U/s.5(a) Indian Explosive Substance Act 2001 and there is a fair chance to succeeding the case and also argued that the petitioners are the law abiding citizens. Hence, he prays to suspend the execution of sentence passed in C.C.No.152/2023 dated 09.05.2025. Further the said sentence has been suspended by the trial court in CrI.M.P.No.05/2025 dated 06.06.2025 he prays for suspension of sentence till the disposal of the Criminal Appeal.

3. The Learned Public Prosecutor does not raise any serious objection to suspend the sentence against the petitioners/accused.

4. Accordingly, the substantial sentence alone is suspended till the disposal of the Criminal Appeal and the petitioners/accused are hereby granted bail on execution of bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ramanathapuram. Further, the petitioners are directed to report before the appellate Court as and when directed and also directed to co-operate with appeal proceedings.
