This petition came on 02.02.2026 before this court for final hearing in the presence of Thiru.S.Periyasamy, Learned Counsel for the Petitioners/Plaintiffs, Thiru.N.Ilangovan, Learned Counsel for the 2nd Respondent/ 2nd defendant and Thiru.K.Alagarsamy, Learned Counsel for the 3 to 5 Respondents/ 3 to 5 Defendants and upon hearing both sides enquiry and upon perusing the material records and having stood over till this day for consideration, this court delivered the following:

ORDER

This petition has been filed under Order 8 Rule 9 and Sec 151 of Civil Procedure Code seeking permission to file subsequent pleadings.

2. Brief averments of the Petitioners/Plaintiffs in brief:-

The petitioner is the 6th plaintiff in the main suit. He files this petition for himself and on behalf of the other petitioners/plaintiffs. The respondents have made amendment in the additional written statement by way of order in I.A No.10/2025. Hence the petition seeking for the permission of the court to file additional pleadings or else this petitioner will be put to irreparable loss and hardships.

3. Brief averments of the 2nd Respondent/2nd Defendant (Adopted by 3 to 5 Respondents/ 3 to 5 Defendants) in brief:

The respondents deny the averments in the petition. The amendment made in the additional written statement was only of clerical nature. There is no necessity for additional pleadings. Hence prays to dismiss the petition with costs.

4. Point for consideration:-

Whether the petition be allowed and the relief be granted as prayed for?

No documents filed on either side. Heard both sides.

5. Answer to the Point:-

5.1. Heard both sides and available records perused. The respondents/defendants have filed I.A No.10/2025 seeking the permission of the court to amend some clerical errors in the additional written statement and the

same was allowed. Now the petitioners/plaintiffs have filed this present petition to seek the permission of the court to file additional pleadings. The additional pleadings is also filed along with the present petition.

5.2. On perusal of the same, there is no new case or cause of action introduced in the additional pleadings but merely explanation to the amendment made in the additional written statement. Considering that this is a court of first instance and seeing that no new cause of action is introduced, no prejudice will be caused if this petition is allowed. Hence in the light of the above discussions, this petition is allowed. No order as to costs.

6. In the result, this petition is allowed. No order as to costs.
