This petition was coming on this day 11.03.2026 for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.N. Chandran Counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.V.T.Ramakrishnan, the learned Special Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides submissions, this Court passes the following...

ORDER

Petition filed by the petitioner / accused (A8) seeking bail U/s.483 of BNSS

The learned counsel for the petitioner / accused (A8) would submit that the respondent police have registered a case against the accused for offences U/s. 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 506(2), 307, 34, 326 of IPC r/w Sec.3(2)(va) of the SC/ST (POA) Act, and the case was taken on file as Spl.SC.No.65/2018. The petitioner/accused was arrested on 25.09.2025, and he was remanded to judicial custody on the same day on execution of a warrant issued against him on 19.07.2025. The petitioner / accused will not tamper with witnesses and will not abscond, and he is ready to furnish substantial sureties. The learned



counsel for the petitioner/accused would further submit that the prosecution case would not be affected in the event of granting bail.

2. The respondent / Police would submit that the petitioner / accused (A8) there is no previous case against him and therefore he has objected to release the petitioner / accused on bail.

3. This Court perused the records and considered submissions of both sides. Considering the fact that the petitioner has been languishing in jail, since 25.09.2025, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner on following conditions.

- 1) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for the like sum.
- 2) the petitioner shall and appear before the respondent Police daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders.
- 3) the petitioner shall maintain peace and co-operate with the investigation.
- 4) the petitioner shall not enter the locality of the Complainant and shall not tamper with evidence or tamper the witness at any stage of proceedings.
- 5) If the petitioner fails to comply with the above conditions, the bail order shall stand cancelled automatically.

In the result, the petition is allowed on the above terms.
