This petition was coming on day 06.03.2026 for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.S.Pranavanathan, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.V.T.Ramakrishnan, the learned Special Public Prosecutor for the State and upon



hearing both sides submissions, this Court passed the following....

**ORDER**

The petitioners who were accused have filed this petition U/s.483 of BNSS Act seeking bail.

The case of the prosecution is that on 08.02.2026 at about 01:30 p.m 15 unidentified persons verbally abused the complainant with casteist slurs assaulted and injured him, when he was standing in front of the Arulmigu Eswari Muthu Irulandi Temple near O.Panaikulam.

2. The learned counsel for petitioners / accused would submit that the respondent Police have registered a case against this petitioners / accused for offences U/s.189(2), 296(b), 115(2) of the BNS Act and Sec.3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 2015. The petitioners / accused has filed a petition in CrI.OP.(MD) No.3729 of 2026 dated 23.02.2026 before the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court and the Hon'ble Madurai Bench Court has directed this court to consider the bail application if any filed by the petitioners / accused on the same day. As per directions of Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, the petitioners have filed this application on 23.02.2026. The learned counsel for accused would submit that the petitioners are ready to abide any condition that may be imposed on them and undertake to furnish substantial sureties in the event of granting bail.



3. This Court has given notice to the defacto complainant as per Section.15(A) of SC/ST Act. The defacto complainant present. He objected to the release of the petitioner/accused on bail.

4. The respondent Complainant Police have contended that the 1<sup>st</sup> accused was released on this court on 25.02.2026. If the petitioners / accused are released on bail, they would tamper with the witnesses and abscond; they will also threaten the witnesses, and therefore, he strongly objected to the release of the petitioners / accused on bail.

5. This Court perused the records and the objections made by the defacto Complainant and respondent Police. Therefore, this Court considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the objections raised by the complainant and defacto complainant and other facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioners / accused are released on bail subject to the following conditions.

- 1) the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for the like sum.
- 2) the petitioners shall appear before the respondent Police daily at 10.00 a.m for until further orders.
- 3) the petitioners shall maintain peace and co-operate with the investigation.
- 4) the petitioners shall not enter the locality of the Complainant and shall not tamper with evidence or tamper the witness at any stage proceedings.
- 5) If the petitioners fail to comply with the above conditions, the bail order shall stand cancelled automatically.
