This petition was coming on this day 09.03.2026 for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.M. Vigneshwaran, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.V.T.Ramakrishnan, the learned Special Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides submissions, this Court passes the following...

**ORDER**

Petition filed by the petitioner / accused (A8) seeking bail U/s.483 of BNSS

The petitioner is A8 in Spl.SC.No.35 of 2023. The respondent police have registered a case against 8 accused U/s.147, 341, 342, 365, 506(2), 109 of IPC and r/w 3(2)(va) of SC/ST Act 2015. This Court upon perusal of records came to understand that the occurrence took place on 25.04.2023 and the case was taken on file by this Court 05.07.2023. This case has been pending for furnishing copies since 2023. Due to non-appearance of accused one after another this case is pending at the stage of furnishing



copies. Considering the pendency of the case for long time at the stage of furnishing copies, this Court is of the considered view that if the petitioner is released on bail, he would abscond and would not co-operate for trial.

2. The learned Special Public Prosecutor has also objected to release the petitioner / accused on bail on the ground that the case is pending for furnishing copies. Earlier application was dismissed on 25.02.2026. This petitioner / accused has one previous case. In the above circumstances, NBW pending against Accused A3 and A5. Therefore, he has objected to release the petitioner / accused on bail.

Therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner / accused and this petition is liable to be dismissed.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.
