This petition was coming on this day 01.06.2026 for hearing before me in the presence of Tmt.P.Sivakami, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.V.T.Ramakrishnan, the learned Special Public Prosecutor for the State and upon hearing both sides submissions, this Court passed the following....

ORDER

Petition filed by the petitioner/ accused seeking bail U/s.483 of BNSS

The petitioner / accused has surrendered himself before this Court today (01.06.2026) and seeks bail.



2. The learned counsel for petitioner / accused would submit that the respondent Police have registered a case against this petitioner / accused for offences U/s. 296(b), 115(2) & 351(3) of BNS Act and Sec.3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (POA) Act 1989. The petitioner/ accused has filed a petition in CrI.O.P.(MD) No.9470 of 2026 dated 13.05.2026 before the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court has directed to surrender to accused before this Court and filed bail to direct this court. Accordingly the petition is surrender himself and also filed the petition. The learned counsel for petitioner / accused would submit that the petitioner is ready to abide any condition that may be imposed on him and undertake to furnish substantial sureties in the event of granting bail.

3. The defacto complainant was given notice, and she has appeared before on this Court on 26.05.2026. She has made her written objection. It is stated that when she was clearing pushes in her punjai land accused assaulted her son with hand and also threatened the dire consequence and also used the filthy language as well as scolded with mentioning her community. It is further contented that if the petitioner / accused is released on bail he will indulging similar offence.

4. The learned Special Public Prosecutor have contended that the defacto complainant while are clearing the pushes in her punjai the accused came and assaulted defacto complainant's son with hand used filthy language and threatened them to face to dire consequence and also scolded with mentioning her community. It is further contended that he will abscond and not co-operate with investigation.



5. If the petitioner is granted bail he will escape from the place and leave to abroad.

It is further contended that the petitioner accused involved in four cases following cases:

1. Mandalamanickkam P.S, Cr.No.33/2011 U/s.147, 148, 341, 302 of IPC r/w 3(2)(v) SC/ST Act.
2. Mandalamanickkam P.S, Cr.No.114/2020 U/s.379 of IPC r/w 21(1) MMDR Act.
3. Mandalamanickkam P.S Cr.No.55/2010 U/s.147, 148, 332,323, 324, 353, 307 of IPC r/w 3(1)(x) SC/ST Act.
4. Kamuthi P.S, Cr.No. 238/2025, U/s.296(b), 115(2) BNS.

6. The petitioner / accused has been registered Cr.No.18/2012 by the respondent police. On perusal of records the community certificate not enclosed along with FIR. Injured did not taken treatment as seen from FIR, objection of defacto complainant as well as prosecution side. Though the learned Special Public Prosecutor mentioned involved in similar offences, those are pertaining to the year 2010 and 2011.

7. So considering the nature and gravity of offence, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner / accused is released on bail subject to the following conditions.

- 1) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for the like sum.
- 2) the petitioner shall appear before the Inspector of Police, Thiruvadanai Police Station twice at 10.00 a.m and 5.00 p.m until further orders.
- 3) the petitioner shall maintain peace and co-operate with the investigation.
- 4) the petitioner shall not enter the locality of the Complainant and shall not tamper with evidence or tamper the witness at any stage proceedings.
- 5) If the petitioner fail to comply with the above conditions, the bail order shall stand cancelled automatically.



In the result, the petition is allowed on the above terms.
