3. Notice given to the Respondent / Complainant and reply given. In reply, the respondent has submitted that the petitioner / accused signed before the respondent Police from 09.05.2026 to till date.

Therefore, having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, the accused have regularly been abiding by the conditions, this Court is inclined to modify the condition imposed on them and as such the accused shall appear before the respondent Police on weekly once on every Monday at 10:00 A.M until further orders.

5. In the result, the petition is partly allowed and the condition is modified to the effect the accused shall appear before the respondent Police on weekly once on every Monday at 10:00 A.M until further orders.
