This bail petition came up before me for hearing on 05.06.2026 in the presence of Tr. G. Kumar Advocate for the Petitioner and the Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-I for the Respondent/Complainant and on perusal of case records, this Court delivers the following:-

BAIL ORDER

1. The petitioner counsel would submit that the petitioner/Accused was remanded on 30.05.2026 under Crime No.52/2026 on the file of the Respondent Police for the offence U/s. 4(1)(A) TNP Amendment Act 2024 and the accused was in judicial custody for the past 5 days and he is innocent and no way connected with the case. Hence, prayed to enlarge the accused on bail.

2. The Respondent/Police opposed to enlarge the accused on bail as she have

committed offences of serious in nature and if the accused was released on bail, there is a possibility that the petitioner will be threatened, there is a possibility that the witnesses will be dispersed and she would indulge in the offences of the same nature. Hence, strongly objected to release the accused on bail.

3. On perusal of records, considering the nature of offence, investigation is almost over, the duration of the custody and the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to release the petitioner/accused on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- along with two sureties, for the like sum for the accused, subject to the condition that the accused shall not tamper the witness and also further the accused should co-operate with the police for investigation and the accused should appear and sign before Respondent Police, from the next day of execution of bond, in the morning at 10.00 a.m. for a period of 15 days including holidays.

4. In the result this petition is allowed.
