**ORDER**

The petitioner/Plaintiff has filed the application U/order VII Rule 14(3) of C.P.C., to receive the additional documents.

1. The petitioner/plaintiff has filed an affidavit stating that the additional documents could not be filed at the time of filing of the plaint and those documents are very essential to prove her case.
2. The respondent/defendant has filed a counter contending that the additional documents are only the certified copies of documents and hence the application cannot be allowed.
3. On perusal of records, it is seen that the plaintiff has filed the above suit for the relief of partition and when the case was posted for chief continuation of

PW1, the present application was filed by the plaintiff to receive the certified copies of sale deed and general power of attorney. Considering the nature of the suit and the reason given in the affidavit, this court is of the view that the application can be allowed subject to admissibility, relevancy and proof of documents.
