This petition is coming before me for final hearing on 18.03.2026 in the presence of Mr.W.Pugazhendhi, Advocate for Petitioner/Decree Holder and the execution petition against R1, R2 and R5 was dismissed for default for non payment of process fee and the Respondents 3 & 4 were called absent and set exparte and upon hearing the argument of petitioner side and on perusal of all connected material records and having stood over for consideration till this date, this court passed the following;

ORDER

The petitioner/decreed holder has filed the Execution Petition Under Order 21; Rule 48 of CPC seeking an order for attachment of salary of the respondents 3 to 5.

a) The petitioner/decreed holder has stated in Column Nos.8 of the Execution Petition that the respondents are liable to pay a total sum of Rs.10,40,770/- as per the decree dated 24.07.2024 passed by the Registrar of Chits, Ranipet. The petitioner has further stated in the Execution Petition that no appeal was preferred by the respondents against the said decree and they are liable to pay the amount claimed in the Execution Petition.

b) The Execution Petition against the respondents 1, 2 and 5 was dismissed for default and the respondents 3 & 4 are remained exparte. The petitioner/decreed holder has prayed to attach the salary of respondents 3 & 4 and they have also produced the copy of pay certificates of respondents 3 & 4 along with a memo on 11.03.2026. In the above circumstances, this court is of the view that it is necessary to pass an order of attachment of salary of the respondents 3 & 4 to realize the decree amount. It is seen from the copies of pay certificates of respondents 3 & 4 that the 3rd respondent was drawing the net monthly salary of Rs.17,883/- and the 4th respondent was drawing the net monthly salary of Rs.18,241/-.

In the result, it is ordered to attach a sum of Rs.5,000/- each from the salary amounts of the respondents 3 & 4 from the month of May-2026 for a total period of 24 months. Issue attachment warrant by 10.06.2026. Batta in 3 days.
