This petition is coming before me for hearing today in the presence of Thiru. A. Mahendrarvarman, learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor appeared on behalf of the respondent, after hearing both sides, this court delivered the following:

**ORDER**

This petition is filed by the petitioner U/s 483 of B.N.S.S., 2023 to grant him bail for the alleged offences U/s. 123 of Baratiya Nyay Sanhita 2023 and 22(a), 8(c) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was remanded to judicial custody on 21.05.2026 and incarcerated for the past

19 days and that the petitioner is working as daily wages worker and seeking their lively hood and that the petitioner is ready and willing to offer sufficient sureties to ensure his regular appearance and to abide by any condition imposed on him and prays to grant bail.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor represented that there are 11 previous cases registered against the petitioner, he is having Hs.No.01/2024 B Category and in this case, the petitioner was arrested for having possessed the prohibited Narcotic Substance namely 'Tapentadol Tablets' and if the petitioner is enlarged on bail he will tamper the witnesses and involve in the similar nature of offences and the investigation is pending and hence, he strongly opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

4. The case was registered against the petitioner for the offences U/s. 123 of Baratiya Nyay Sanhita 2023 and 22(a), 8(c) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985. The petitioner is in judicial custody for the past 19 days. Both side submissions Heard. Records perused. It is the allegation that the petitioner possessed the prohibited Narcotic substance viz., 180nos., of Tapentadol Tablets for sale with higher profit. Taking into consideration of the above facts and circumstances of this case, nature and gravity of the offences, the stage of investigation and also taking note that the petitioner has 11 previous cases, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. In the result, this petition is dismissed.
