This bail petition came up before me for final hearing on 08.06.2026 in the presence of Thiru. P. Prasanna Kumar, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-I for the Respondent/Complainant and on perusal of case records, this Court delivers the following:-

BAIL ORDER

1. The petitioner counsel would submit that the petitioner/Accused is arrested on 02.06.2026 under Crime No.122/2026 on the file of the Respondent Police for the offence U/s. 303(2), 326(a) of BNS the accused is in judicial custody for the past 6 days and he is innocents and no way connected with the case. Hence, prayed to enlarge the accused on bail.

2. The Respondent/Police opposed to enlarge the accused on bail as he his committed offences of serious in nature and if he is released on bail he would indulge in the offences of the same nature, tampering of witness is also possible. Hence, objected to

release the accused on bail.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances, nature of offence, the alleged offence is theft of river sand. Accused has alleged to have stolen 1 Unit sand of "River Sand" in his Mahendira Tracker and trailer. Considering that the investigation is almost complete and also the period of incarceration, this court is inclined to release the petitioner/accused on bail on executing a bond for a each sum of Rs. 10,000/- each along with two sureties, one blood surety for the like sum for the accused, subjected to the condition that the accused shall not tamper the witness and also further the accused should co-operate with the police for investigation and the accused should appear and sign before Respondent Police, from the next day of execution of bond, in the morning at 10.00 a.m. for a period of 15 days including holidays.

4. The petitioner is also directed to deposit a each sum of Rs.5,000/- before the Jurisdictional Tahsildar concerned and on deposit the said amount has to be deposited by Jurisdictional Tahsildar concerned to the credit of the District Mines and Minerals Foundation Trust as non refundable deposit.

5. In the result, petition is allowed.
