This petition is coming before me for hearing today in the presence of Thiru.K.Thean Amudhan Learned counsel for the Petitioners and the Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent and considering that after hearing both sides, this court delivered the following:

ORDER

The petitioners are the Accused A1, A4 to A6 filed this petition under section 483(1)(b) of BNSS to relax the condition imposed by this court in C.M.P. No.4/2026 dated: 27.01.2026.

2. Brief of petition:-

The petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 were released on bail as per order in C.M.P.No.4/2026 dated:27.01.2026 with condition to appear before this court daily at 10.00 A.M without fail until further orders. The petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 abide the conditions for about 32 days. The petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 are the only bread winner of their family and they have to go for work nearly 35 kms. Due to the above said reasons, the petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 finds very difficult to abide the conditions imposed by this court. Hence, the present petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed by this court.

3. Objections filed by the prosecution:-

This court directed the petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 to appear and sign before this court daily at 10.30 AM in C.M.P.No.4/2026. If the condition is relaxed, there are chances to commit the similar type of offences. Therefore, prayed to dismiss the above petition.

4. The petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 have filed this petition to relax the condition imposed by this court in C.M.P.No.4/2026 on 27.01.2026 in S.C.No.118/2025 on the ground that they had complied with the conditions for about 32 days and now they are unable to comply with the conditions due to their family situations.

5. The petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 side argued that the petitioners have been arrayed as A1, A4 to A6 and they were produced before this court on execution of Non-Bailable Warrant and subsequently released on bail on 27.01.2026. While they were enlarged on bail they were directed to appear before this court daily at 10.30 am without fail until further orders. The Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed this petition on the ground that if the condition is relaxed the petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 will not appear before this court for trial, hence prayed to dismiss the petition.

6. After hearing the arguments of both sides, the petitioners have been arrayed as A1, A4 to A6 in the above case and while they enlarged on bail this court directed them to appear before this court daily at 10.00 AM without fail until further orders. Now, they find it very difficult to comply with the conditions imposed by this court due to family situations. On perusal of the available material records, the petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 so far complied with the conditions for about 32 days. The petitioners are arrayed as A1, A4 to A6 in the above case. The case has been pending from 2023 onwards for the appearance of all the accused and finally on 04.09.2025 only the charges were framed by this court and now it is posted for trial. Due to the non-co-operation of the accused this case was pending for a long time. While the petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 were enlarged on bail on 27.01.2026 they were directed to appear before this court daily at 10.00 AM without

fail. The petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 have complied with for about 32 days of the conditions imposed by this court. Therefore, this court is inclined to allow this petition.

In the result, this petition is allowed and the conditions imposed by this court in C.M.P.4/2026 dated: 27.01.2026 is relaxed and the petitioners/A1, A4 to A6 are directed to appear before this court once on all future hearing dates.
