This petition came up before me for hearing on 11.03.2026, Learned Counsel Mr.M.Vetrivel, appeared for petitioner, Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-II appeared for the respondent, upon hearing both side and perusing the entire records, this Court delivers the following:-

ORDER

This petition filed u/s.480 BNSS praying to enlarge the accused on bail against the alleged offence u/s.118(1), 296(b), 351(3) Bns Act.

2. On behalf of the petitioner submitted that false case foisted against the petitioner and petitioner is in judicial custody from 04.03.2026. On behalf of the petitioner submitted that this petition is the 1st bail petition and the petitioner is ready to obey any condition imposed by this Court and petitioner is bread winner of the family.

3. On behalf of the respondent stoutly opposed that if the petitioner enlarge on bail will involve similar offence and may abscond. On behalf of respondent stoutly opposed that if the petitioner enlarged on bail will tamper witness.

4. The Point for determination is whether the petitioner is entitle to bail?

5. Heard both side. Records perused. Considering facts of the case, considering nature of the offence, Considering that petitioner is being in custody from 04.03.2026, Considering that the victim is discharged. Further considering that the petitioner is ready to obey the condition imposed by this Court, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner on the following conditions:-

(i)	That the petitioner should execute bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with 2 sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of this Court.
(ii)	That the petitioner should appear before the respondent police at 09.00 a.m. and should sign for 10 days from the date of his release.
(iii)	That the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness.
(iv)	That the petitioner should not leave India without permission of this Court.
(v)	That the petitioner should appear before this Court and respondent police as and when required.

Finally, on the above said conditions this petition is allowed.
