ORDER

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of Civil Procedure Code seeking for transfer of the petition in H.M.O.P.No.155/2024 pending on the file of the Subordinate Court, Mettur to the file of the Family Court, Salem.

2. The petitioner, in her application, states that the application is filed in HMOP to dissolve the marriage of the petitioner and the respondent and the case is posted for enquiry. Now, the petitioner is residing under the care and custody of her father and the Court where the original petition was filed is far away from

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her residential place, at a distance of 65 km. and there is every chance of her life being threatened by the respondent when the petitioner visits the Court at Mettur for hearing and it is inconvenient for her to attend the Court proceedings. Hence, the present application is filed.

3. The application was resisted by the respondent stating that no valid reasons have been given seeking for transfer.

4. However, considering the fact that the convenience of the parties are paramount and the petitioner since reported that her life would be at threat if the matter is allowed to continue in Mettur Sub Court, hence, the petition is allowed.

In the result, the petition is allowed. The petition in H.M.O.P.No.155/2024 pending before the Subordinate Court, Mettur is ordered to be transferred to the Family Court, Salem to try in accordance with law. No costs.
