This petition is filed on 25.02.2026 under section 483(1)(b) of B.N.S.S., to relax the bail condition imposed on the petitioners.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Tr.R.M.Udhayakumar, Counsel for the petitioners and the Public Prosecutor for the respondent, after perusing the averments, this Court delivered the following:

ORDER

Heard both side and records perused. The petitioners who were granted anticipatory bail vide the order of this Court in CMP.No.14/2026, dated 05.01.2026 with a condition to appear and sign before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Addl. Mahila Court, Salem daily at 10.00 a.m., except holidays, until further orders (for a minimum period of 30 days), have come forward with this petition seeking to relax the bail condition imposed on them.

2) The learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have complied with the condition from 09.01.2026 onwards; due to bail condition, the petitioners are not able to attend their day to day work, hence, the condition imposed on the petitioners may be totally relaxed and prayed to allow this petition.

3) The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioners are abiding the condition before the Judicial Magistrate, Addl. Mahila Court, Salem.

4) On perusal of the report received from the learned Judicial Magistrate, Addl. Mahila Court, Salem, it reveals that the petitioners are abiding the condition for the past 35 days from 09.01.2026 onwards without any deviation.

5) In the stated circumstances, considering the fact that the petitioners have complied the condition regularly without any deviation, this Court is inclined to relax the bail condition imposed on the petitioners.

6) In the result, this petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioners are totally relaxed. The petitioners are directed to appear before the concerned Court on receipt of summons.
