

without fail; the petitioner is working as a labour and he is the only bread winner of his family; due to bail condition, he is not able to attend his day to day work; hence, the condition imposed on the petitioner may be totally relaxed.

3) The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioner complied with the condition daily from 14.02.2026 to 17.03.2026. Thereafter, the petitioner has not appeared and signed before the respondent/police to date.

4) During enquiry, the learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the condition imposed on the petitioner may be modified.

5) In the stated circumstances, considering the submission made by the petitioner's side and the period of complying the condition by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to modify the condition and **the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the respondent/police weekly once on every Monday at 10.00 a.m., until further orders.**

6) In the result, this petition is partly allowed.
