The petition is coming before me for final hearing on 04.02.2026 in the presence of Thiru.A.Velkumar, Advocate for the petitioners and upon hearing the argument of the petitioners side and upon perusing the case records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivered the following.

**Order**

The petition was filed by the petitioners seeking to issue a Succession Certificate in favour of the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner namely N.Santhana Krishnan regarding the share certificate amounts invested by P.Natarajan and N.Muthulakshmi with the dividend and unclaimed dividends if any as shown

in the schedule and direct the TVS Motor Company Limited, to pay the petitioners.

2. The petitioners are the brothers and sisters and legal heirs of the deceased P.Natarajan and Muthulakshmi. They are voluntarily filing this petition mutually. Hence there is no respondents in this proceedings. The 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner is the son and the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> petitioners are the daughters of Late.P.Natarajan and Late.N.Muthulakshmi. The Late P.Natarajan and Late.N.Muthulakshmi had one more son named N.Ramachandran and a daughter named Rajalakshmi who are brother and sister of the petitioners. The said N.Muthulakshmi died intestate on 27.12.1984 and P.Natarajan died intestate on 16.12.1987. The said N.Ramachandran died intestate on 26.08.2016 leaving behind his wife and R.Jayashankari (2<sup>nd</sup> petitioner) and his only son R.Sankararaman (3<sup>rd</sup> petitioner) as his legal heirs. The said Rajalakshmi died intestate on 05.01.2023 and her husband predeceased her on 22.03.1991 both of them leaving behind her son S.Sankar Ram (4<sup>th</sup> petitioner) and their daughter S.Sudha (6<sup>th</sup> petitioner) as their legal heirs. The 2<sup>nd</sup> petitioner is the daughter -in-law and the petitioners 3 to 5 are the grand-children's of the deceased P.Natarajan and N.Muthulakshmi. During the life time of P.Natarajan and Muthulakshmi they have jointly purchased 500 equity shares of Rs.1/- in TVS Motors Company Limited under registered folio

No.N1305 and as on date there is an accrued bonus shares of 500 shares. As on the date the said Natarajan and Muthulakshmi totally hold 1000 shares which are held in electronic DMAT form with the company registrar M/s. Integrated Registry Management Services Private Limited as mentioned below vide their letter dated 14.02.2022

Other than the petitioners herein there is no one else have right to claim the properties of the deceased P.Natarajan and N.Muthulakshmi. Accordingly these petitioners are succeeding the shares and its dividends of the deceased. The 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner on 14.02.2024 through S.Anuadha a practicing company secretary approached the Registrar of the company namely M/s. Integrated Registry Management Services Private Limited, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, “Kences Towers”, No.1, Ramakrishna Street, North Usman Road, T.Nagar, Chennai -17 to pay him the share amounts with dividends invested by P.Natarajan and N.Muthulakshmi in the said TVS Motor Company Limited, but they directed the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner to approach the competent civil court to get succession

certificate. Hence the petitioners prays to issue the Succession Certificate to receive the share amount with all the dividends pertaining to the shares invested by P.Natarajan and N.Muthulakshmi. Hence this petition.

3. In this petition, the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner was examined as P.W.1 and Ex.P1 to Ex.P17 were marked.

4. From the above evidence whether the petitioners are entitled for Succession Certificate or not is the question. The 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner has examined himself as P.W.1 and narrated the facts of the case. In this case the P.W.1 has produced the letter written by Integrated Corporate Solutions to the company secretary of the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner was marked as Ex.P1. The death certificate of N.Muthulakshmi was marked as Ex.P2, she died on 29.12.1984, Ex.P3 is the legal heirship Certificate of N.Muthulakshmi, it reveals that Ramachandran, Santhanakrishnan, Rajalakshmi, Lalitha, Uma Gowri and Natarajan are the legal heirs of the Muthulakshmi, Ex.P4 is the death certificate of P.Natarajan dated 16.12.1987, Ex.P5 is the legal heirship certificate of P.Natarajan it reveals that Santhanakrishnan, Rajalakshmi, Lalitha and Uma Gowri are the legal heirs of the said Natarajan. Ex.P6 is the death certificate of Ramachandran dated 26.08.2016, Ex.P7 is the legal heirship certificate of Ramachandran it reveals that Jayasankari and Sankararaman are the legal heirs of the said Ramachandran. Ex.P8 is the

death certificate of Rajalakshmi dated 05.01.2023, Ex.A9 is the legal heirship certificate, Ex.P11 is the Share trade price details, Ex.P10, P12 to Ex.P17 are the Aadhaar cards of the petitioners 2 to 7.

5. On perusing the above said documents the petitioners are the legal heirs of the P.Natarajan and N.Muthulakshmi. The petitioners 2 to 7 have authorized the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner by giving no objection affidavit to deal with the share holding company, to apply and to receive the sale proceeds if any. Hence the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner to get the Share Certificate Folio No: N1305 issued by TVS Motor Company Limited to transfer in the name of the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner. There is no counter claim from any one. Considering the all these aspects this court inclined to grant succession certificate to the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner.

In the result this petition is allowed, issue Succession Certificate in favour of the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner namely N.Santhana Krishnan regarding the share certificate amounts invested by P.Natarajan and N.Muthulakshmi with the dividend and unclaimed dividends if any as shown in the schedule and direct the TVS Motor Company Limited, to pay the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner.
