JUDGMENT

Suit for Declaration and Consequential Injunction. To pass a decree of declaration, declaring that the plaintiff is the title holder of the suit property and consequently grant a decree of permanent injunction interdicting the defendants 2 to 4 and their men from in any way interfering with the peaceful possession, enjoyment of the suit property, and awarding cost of the suit.

IA.1/2020 (Or1 R10) is dismissed. Plaintiff is not present. No representation. Hon'ble High Court of Madras give a direction in CRP (NPD) No.2358/14 in MP No.1/14 Dt 30.4.19. The above case is disposed within 31.7.2020. But till date not completed PW1 cross examined. Ample chance is given to the plaintiff (PW1). Hence, suit is dismissed for default with cost.
