JUDGMENT

Suit for Permanent Injunction. To pass a decree in favour of the plaintiff against the defendants by, restraining the defendants 1 to 3 and their men, agents, servants, executors or assignees from alienating or encumbering the suit property by means of permanent injunction, restraining the defendants and their men, agents and servants from disturbing the plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit property by means of permanent injunction, and awarding cost of the suit to the plaintiff by the defendants 1 to 3.

PW1 is present (Pass over) for after lunch. At 2.30 p.m. called PW1 is not present. No representation. Again at 3.48 p.m. called 3 times PW1 is not present. No representation. D1 to D3 side ready to cross examination of PW1. The above case is pending for trial in list on 10.06.19 as well as pending for more than 7 years. Ample chance is given. Hence, suit is dismissed for default with cost.
