ORDER

Disposal Type: Judgement on admission

Accused no.2 and 3 present. Accused no.2 and 3 were questioned about the offence and they admitted the offence and filed admission petition through online and allowed. Sufficient materials exist against the accused no.2 and 3 to convict them for the offence U/s. 59(i) of Food Safety and Standards Act. Hence, Accused no.2 and 3 are found guilty for the offence U/s. 59(i) of Food Safety and Standards Act and hence, the accused no.2 and 3 are convicted for the offence U/s. 59(i) of Food Safety and Standards Act. Since, the complainant has not stated in the complaint that the accused no.2 and 3 has previous bad antecedent and have not shown/proved before the Court that the accused no.2 and 3 have been previously convicted for the similar kind of offence, this Court is of the view that the accused no.2 and 3 are first time offender. This Court is of the further considered view that the accused no.2 and 3 being the first offender an opportunity may be afforded so as to enable the accused no.2 and 3 to realize their mistake and refrain them from committing any further similar kind of offence in future by imposing a minimum fine and sentence, and hence this Court considers the same as a special reason to impose a lesser sentence/punishment to the accused no.2 and 3 for the alleged offence. Hence, this Court sentences the accused no.2 and 3 for the offence under section 59(i) of Food Safety and Standards Act to one day simple imprisonment till raising of Court and imposes a fine of Rs.5000/- each and in default the accused no.2 and 3 shall undergo one month Simple imprisonment for the said offence. Since, the case against the accused no.1 has been split up in S.T.C.254/2026, the property order in the above case

will be passed while the case in S.T.C.254/2026 is disposed. Total fine Rs.10,000/-.
