This Petition is coming on 27th day of July 2026 for hearing before me and having stood over for consideration till this date and this court delivers the following :

ORDER

The Accused has filed an application under section 389(3) Cr.P.C thereby expressing his intention to file appeal against the Judgment passed in the above case, which resulted in an order of sentence. By virtue of this application the accused prays that till filing of the appeal sentence of imprisonment may be suspended.

Point for Consideration: Whether the Present Petition is to be allowed or not.?

1. Heard. Record perused. The present petition is filed by the petitioner/accused that he intends to file an Appeal against the conviction order passed against him. This Court is satisfied with the fact that the accused intends to prefer an appeal against his conviction. It is pertinent to state that the accused was on bail during the Trial of the case and that the sentence imposed on the accused is simple imprisonment for a term of one year and to pay a compensation of Rs.5,00,000/-.

2. Since, the sentence imposed on the petitioner does not exceed three years and that the accused was on bail during the Trial of the case, this Court on considering the above facts, and in the Interest of Justice suspends the sentence imposed on the petitioner/accused, for enabling him to prefer an Appeal against the said conviction, for a period of 30 days from the date of this order, on condition that he shall surrender before the Court and file a report before this Court on 25.08.2026, that the said Appeal was filed before the Hon'ble Appellate Court. The accused is further directed to execute a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- alongwith two sureties for likewise sum.

3. The Head Ministerial Officer of this Court is directed to keep the suspension bail bonds pending and to put up these papers before me on the date (25.08.2026) fixed with the report whether any bail order has been produced or not. However main file be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
