ORDER

Disposal Type: Delay Condoned

Petitioner / Complainant absent. Petition filed online and allowed. Heard. Records perused. The Petitioner has stated in the Affidavit that the petitioner is affected by jaundice, and hence the said delay of 94 days has occurred in filing the above complaint. This Court had issued notice to the Respondent no.1 and 2 through R.P.A.D seeking objections in the above petition. The said notices were returned as "Left without intimation" by the Respondents and the Respondents were called absent in open Court and there was no representation for the Respondents. The Respondent no.1 is the company and the Respondent no.2 is the proprietor of Respondent no.1 company. The Respondent no.2 neither appeared nor filed any objections and hence this Court had closed the opportunity granted to them for filing their objections. This Court on considering the facts stated in the Affidavit, is of the view that since the petitioner was affected with jaundice he could not contact his counsel for giving instructions to his counsel in proceeding with the case. The Respondent having not appeared and having not objected the facts stated by the petitioner in the Affidavit, this Court reckons that the petitioner has shown sufficient cause for having not making a complaint within the prescribed period. Hence, for the aforesaid reasons, this Court is of the view that the reasons stated by the petitioner for not having filed the complaint within the prescribed period is satisfactory. Hence, this Court for the reasons stated as aforesaid and in the interest of justice condones the delay of 94 days in filing the complaint for taking cognizance of the same. Thus, the petition is allowed.
