Today is fixed for hearing of Misc Case filed by petitioner, namely, Md. Guddu @ Md. Azad praying for bail u/s 483 B.N.S.S. in reference to Shibpur P.S. Case No.05/2025, dt.02.01.2025, u/s 126(2)/78/351(2)/79/3(5) of B.N.S. and Section 8/10 of POCSO Act.

Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner is present.

The Misc. Case is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides and considered.

Perused the petition and considered. It is stated that the petitioner is languishing in J.C. since 08.04.2025. It is also stated that the petitioner is innocent. It is further stated that no bail application is pending before any Higher Forum. On this ground the petitioner prayed for bail.

By filing the petition, Ld. Advocate for the defence counsel submits the same fact.

Ld. Spl. P.P. is present who has opposed the bail prayer strongly.

De facto complainant has been issued notice and she is present in Court and raised objection.

Perused the materials on record and C.D.

It has been alleged that the accused, namely, Md. Munna @ Md. Shahzada and the petitioner disturbed the victim by giving bad proposal, holding her hand and touching the private part of victim and they also threatened victim that if she disclosed the matter they will throw acid on her face. On 01.01.2025, at about 07:30 p.m. when victim was going for some work, the petitioner caught hold her and started kissing her. When de facto complainant went to the house of the other accused, the family members assaulted de facto complainant along with other with fist and blows.

Perused the statement of victim recorded u/s 183 of B.N.S.S.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that charge-sheet has already been submitted, I am inclined to enlarge this petitioner on interim bail.

The petitioner, namely, Md. Guddu @ Md. Azad, may find interim bail of Rs.5,000/-, with one registered surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M., Howrah, on condition that the petitioner will not tamper the evidence or threaten the witnesses in any manner whatsoever and to appear on all the dates fixed, i.d to J.C.

Thus the Criminal Misc. Case is disposed of.

C.D. be returned.
