This Petition coming today (10.03.2026) before me for enquiry in the presence of the Tr.R.Ragavan, Advocate appearing for petitioner. Upon perusing entire records and this court delivering the following,

Order

- 1 This petition filed u/s 480 of BNSS, for seeking bail to petitioner/ Accused, alleged offence U/s. 296(b), 118(1), 351(3), 74 BNS.
- 2 As per the Averments of Petition that the accused did not commit any offence, the police foisted false case against the petitioner/Accused, he is innocent and no way connected in the above alleged offences.
- 3 On reply, in this case, investigation is still pending. The person who attacked the accused and was in a conditional plea in that case, violated the conditional plea and attacked the accused again and committed the same crimes, and the 1st Accused is absconding. If the accused is released on bail they will do same offence in future and unable to present before this Hon'ble Court in during the trial, and he may be threatening the witnesses and tampering the evidence. In this stage I strongly opposed to grant bail. Therefore this Hon'ble court this petition may be dismissed this petition under this render justice.

4 Both side heard. Records Perused. Petitioner/ Accused remanded on 21.02.2026. He is in Judicial Custody for past 18 days. The person who attacked the accused and was in a conditional plea in that case, violated the conditional plea and attacked the accused again and committed the same crimes, and the 1st Accused is absconding. Upon considering the facts and circumstances of this case it is revealed that offences is grave in nature and against society. Hence this court finds substance in the contention of respondent that if the accused is released on bail there will be chance of escaping from the clutches of law and will tamper with the prosecution witnesses. Hence from considering the nature of the offense, stage of case, this court is not inclined to allow this petition.

In result, this petition is dismissed accordingly.
