02. The brief facts which led to the instant prosecution case are on the complaint of complainant Jagdish son of Kanhiya Lal, resident of village Ashra Ka Majra, Tesil Bawal, District Rewari and brief fact of the present complaint is that they are four brothers out of which two brothers have died. His younger brother Kartar has died in an accident and Kartar's wife Rajwati died while giving birth to a boy Guddu. Now the problem was to take care of Guddu (*Monu*). His parents refused to take care of Guddu. Then he called his grandparents but they also refused to take care of Guddu. In such situation, his wife Omwati look after Guddu. They brought him and his two sisters and kept them with great love and affection and they also got both his sisters married. When Guddu turned almost 21 years, he got engaged in village Mohammadpur Ahir Tabdi. After some time, girl's family went to fix the date of marriage but Guddu refused to get the marriage and ran away from home. The people of village Mohammadpur gave an application to police station for demanding dowry. He along-with other persons went to police station and it was decided in Panchayat that girl's family should return the articles of the boy's family and boy's family should return the articles of girl's family. Similarly, after reaching the compromise the police did not take any action. Due to this he raised enemy with him and his wife and started living separately in a house at Bawal. Whenever he visited the house, he abused them and threatened to kill them. He would say that he will get

marriage and who are you to get him married. His wife usually remains ill. Yesterday, at about 03:15 he had taken his wife to Alwar by train. On 04.03.2026 at about 07:00 PM, Guddu came to their house and broke the lock of house and set all the articles kept in their house on fire and at 10:00 PM he left the house on fire and told him on phone that whatever you want to do, he will do the same to you. Therefore, it is prayed that action be taken against the accused.

03. Upon this complaint, present case was got registered. Investigation was carried out. Site plan of the place of occurrence was prepared. Statements of witnesses under Section 180 of BNSS were recorded. Accused was arrested in the present case. On completion of the investigation proceedings supplementary final report against accused named above under Section 193 of BNSS was submitted in the Court.

04. Copy of the final report, as required under Section 230 of BNSS, was supplied to both accused, free of costs, complete in all respects, to the satisfaction of the accused.

05. Heard. From the perusal of report under Section 193 of BNSS and accompanied documents, the essential ingredients of Sections 326 (g), 333, 351(2), 238-C BNS has been attracted. *Offences punishable*

:-4:-

under Sections 326(g) of BNS is exclusively triable by Hon'ble Court of Session. Therefore, instant case is being committed to Hon'ble Court of Session for trial for 20.07.2026. Accused Guudu, who is on bail is directed to appear before the Court of Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Rewari on date fixed. Calendera of witnesses be prepared. This order of commitment has been dictated in the presence of learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the State, so, commitment of this case to the Court of Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Rewari, stands notified to the learned Public Prosecutor of Session Court through learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the State. Ahlmad concerned is directed to ensure that case file complete in all respect, be put before Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Rewari, well in time.
