In view of Articles 21 & 22 of the Procedure for Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (fifth Amendment) Rules 2022, the DAR is treated as claim petition u/s 166, Motor Vehicles Act 1988.

Since the insurance company has put in its appearance today, it is directed to examine DAR and file an appropriate response in the prescribed Form in terms of the Articles 26 & 31 of Procedure for Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (fifth Amendment) Rules, 2022 in this Tribunal within 30 days with advance copy to the petitioner. R-2/ Insurance Company shall also furnish its complete bank details in the WS. In case of default/delay in filing of the said response, appropriate costs shall be imposed upon the insurance company.

Driver cum Owner is directed to file his reply to the DAR within 30 days from today with advance copy to the opposite party.

The IO submits that he had intimated the petitioner regarding the filing of the DAR today but the petitioner is seemingly not interested in pursuing the present proceedings and she is presently in Kolkata.

Let notice of the present DAR be issued to the petitioner through the IO for the next date of hearing with the liberty to the petitioner to join through VC on the next date.

The MISC file bearing no. 311/2026 pertaining to the FAR and the orders passed thereon be attached and clubbed with the present DAR.

Put up for appearance of the petitioner, completion of pleadings exploring the possibility of settlement, if any, else framing of issues alongwith connected matter bearing MACT No. 365/2026 on **29.09.2026**.
