This petition coming today for final hearing in the presence of the learned counsel for the petitioner Mr.S.Arul Vignesh, and the respondent police and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Gr.II for the respondent after hearing both sides and examining the material records, having stood over till this date for consideration this court deliver the following:

ORDER

Heard. Records perused. The accused had filed application U/s 480 BNSS seeking for bail. The accused was remanded to custody on 01.03.2026 in Cr.No.71/2026 of Mecheri Police station for the offence alleged has been committed u/s 296(b), 118(1), 115(2), 351(3) BNS. The accused has filed this application contending that he is not guilty and he did not commit the said offence and he is respectable person of the society. Hence, the accused may be released on bail on imposing any condition.

The prosecution opposed the application contending that if the accused is released on bail he may abscond and tamper the witnesses and the investigation yet to be completed and he may involve the same kind of offences again.

The learned counsel who appeared for the accused contended that the said case is falsely foisted. The accused was remanded to Judicial Custody on 01.03.2026 and is in custody for more than 9 days. The Victim has been discharged from the Hospital. The Prosecution also admitted the same in the reply notice. Considering the contentions putforth by both sides, this court is inclined to release the accused on bail considering the period of incarceration and for the reason that the victim had been discharged from the hospital. Hence, this court is inclined to grant bail with the following condition.

1) The accused shall execute bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for the like sum each.

2) The accused shall appear before this court and sign daily at 10.00.A.M for 30 days, Except holidays.
