Having heard this application in the presence of **Mr.G.Loganathan**, the learned counsel for the accused and **Mr.T.Suresh**, Assistant Public Prosecutor, the learned counsel for the complainant and having consideration of the said application till date, this court on merit doth the following

**ORDER**

Heard. Records perused. Both the accused had filed application U/s 437 crpc seeking for bail. The accused was remanded to custody on 18.05.2023 in Cr.No.269/2023 of Mecheri Police station for the offence alleged have been committed u/s 506(ii) of IPC r/w 8(c), r/w 20(b)(ii)(A) NDPS Act. The accused has filed this application contending that she is not guilty and she did not commit the said offence and he is respectable person of the society. Hence, the accused may be released on bail on imposing any condition.

The prosecution opposed the application contending that if the accused is released on bail she may abscond and tamper the witnesses and the investigation yet to be completed and she may involve the same kind of offences again.

The learned counsel who appeared for the accused contended the said case is falsely foisted against the accused. The accused was remanded to Judicial Custody on 18.05.2023 and is in custody for morethan 10 days. Considering the contentions putforth by both sides, this court is inclined to release the accused on bail considering the period of incarceration with the following condition.

1. The accused shall execute bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for the like sum each.
2. The accused shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00.A.M for 30 days.
