The petition coming on this day for final hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.K.Ramki, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Thiru.A.Alagarsamy, Public Prosecutor for the State, after hearing both sides and perusing the written reply submitted by the respondent and records, this Court delivers the following :

ORDER:-

1. This petition has been filed u/s.483(b) of B.N.S.S., to modify the condition imposed by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.232/2026, dated:03.02.2026.
2. The offences alleged are punishable u/s.191(1), 296(b), 115(1), 118(2), 329(4), 351(3) of B.N.S Act.
3. It has been stated in the petition that the petitioner has been granted Anticipatory bail by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.232/2026 by order dated:03.02.2026 with a condition that the petitioners shall appear and sign before the Respondent police station daily at morning at 10.00 a.m., and shall sign for 30 days. As per the direction of this Court, the petitioner had complied the condition from 18.02.2026 till date. Hence, the petitioner had came up with this petition to modify the order imposed on bail by this Court.

4. The respondent orally stating that the petitioner is abiding the condition without any deviation. However, if the condition is modified, there is a likelihood of the petitioner committing further offences in future.

5. Considering the reason stating the petitioner seeking for modification. This Court finds that the above circumstances and the petitioner is made out the case to modify the condition. The reason stating the petitioner for modification is found to be daily. Hence, the condition was modified.

In the result, *this petition is allowed* and the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.232/2026, dated:03.02.2026 is modified and the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station, weekly once on every Saturday morning at 10.00 a.m., for 4 weeks, thereafter he should appear before the Court concerned on receipt of summon except the above modification, the other conditions imposed holds good.
