This petition coming on this day for final hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.R.Murugan, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.A.Alagarsamy, Public Prosecutor for the State, after hearing both sides and perusing the written reply submitted by the respondent and records, this court delivers the following . . .

ORDER:-

1. This petition has been filed u/s.483(b) B.N.S.S., to relax the condition imposed by this Court in Cr.M.P.No.436/2026, dated:27.02.2026.
2. The offences alleged are punishable u/s.296(b) of B.N.S Act and 4 of TNPWH Act.
3. It has been stated in the petition that the petitioner has already been granted Anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.367/2026 by order dated:18.02.2026 with a condition that the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police station weekly twice on every Saturday and Sunday morning at 10.00 a.m., for 6 weeks. Further, the said condition was modified in Crl.M.P.436/2026 by order dated:27.02.2026 with a condition that the petitioner is

directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station, weekly once on every Sunday morning at 10.00 a.m., for 6 weeks. As per the direction of this Court, the petitioner had complying the condition from 2 weeks. The petitioner side represents that the petitioner is a school Head Master, so he could not comply the condition imposed against him. Hence, the petitioner had came up with this petition to relax the order imposed on bail by this Court.

4. The respondent orally stating that the petitioner is abiding the condition without any deviation and there is no serious objection to relax the condition.

5. Considering the reason stating the petitioner seeking for relaxation. This Court finds that the conditions have been complied without delay. Hence, the condition was relaxed.

In the result, ***this petition is allowed*** and the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.MP.No.436/2026, dated:27.02.2026 is fully relaxed and thereafter, directed to appear on summons.
