The petition coming on this day for final hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.RMK.Ramprabakar, Advocate for the Petitioners and of Thiru.A.Alagarsamy, Public Prosecutor for the State, after hearing both sides and perusing the written reply submitted by the respondent and records, this Court delivers the following :

ORDER:-

1. This petition has been filed u/s.483(1)(b) of B.N.S.S., to modify the condition imposed by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.317/2026, dated:10.02.2026.
2. The offences alleged are punishable u/s.191(2), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(2) of B.N.S Act and 4 of TNPWH Act.
3. It has been stated in the petition that the petitioners have been granted Anticipatory bail by this Court in Cr.M.P.No.317/2026 by order dated:10.02.2026 with a condition that the petitioners shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station weekly twice on every Wednesday and Sunday at morning at 10.00 a.m., and shall sign for 4 weeks. As per the order, the petitioners are abiding the condition till

date. The petitioners are senior citizens, so they could not able to abide the condition. Hence, the petitioners have came up with this petition to modify the order imposed on bail by this Court.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor has strongly contended that the petitioners stating in his petition is not sustainable and if the condition is modified, there is a likelihood of the petitioner committing further offences in future. Hence, prays for dismissal of the petition.

5. By considering the submissions of the parties and the fact that there is no satisfactory reasons have been given by the petitioners for modifying the condition. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to allow the petition.

In the result, ***this petition is dismissed.***
